MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:

019 Reviewed the Minutes of the Rally Advisory Panel meeting of 7th March 2012, noted.

BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES:

020 Ref. RAP12.011 - 2012 Qld Rally Championship and Series Schedule

Noted that the schedule on the CAMS website is still incorrect. Panel Chair to follow up with the CAMS Qld Office.

021 Ref: RAP12.012 - Mex Maintenance Software Sponsorship

MEX Press Release has been sent to Car Clubs and Magazines for wider publication/distribution. Quotes to make and supply the MEX windscreen banners are being sought from three different sign writing companies.

022 Ref: RAP12.013 - Traffic Control Officials (TCO)
Letter received from John Keen detailing his findings on TCOs.
Differing laws between Qld & NSW creates a problem for the GCTMSC running their event in Northern NSW. Barry Neuendorff to speak to Laurence Svenson with regards to CAMS training. To be carried forward.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

- 023 Discussion on who handles incoming emails to RAP; Panel Chair to decide who and delegate depending on area of expertise required.
- 024 Point Scorer to follow up with the CAMS Qld Office to be kept updated on who has registered for QRC and QSS.
- 025 General discussion on RallySafe monitoring for QRC and ACR entrants in IRoC.
- 026 Windscreen decals etc to be made available at scrutineering at events. The first event being IRoQ.
- 027 General discussion on how to spend the MEX sponsorship money. Safety items such as MIV and TCO as high priority. To be carried forward.
- 028 Steve Davies questioned how the ten dollar levy at article 2.13.2 of the Rally Handbook would be applied to non-QRC or QSS registered vehicles.
- 029 Peter Marcovich noted that the RAP website hosting fees were due for payment. He will pay them and seek reimbursement. Barry Neuendorff is to confirm whether Saab Care will continue its sponsorship of paying for the hosting.
- 030 The scrutineering team asked Panel Chair to release a bulletin to the wider rally community detailing the pending changes for roll bar padding due for 2013. Dave Wood to email Panel Chair with the finer details.
- 031 A general discussion was held regarding MEX and their clients' involvement in a sponsor's ride day at Willowbank at a date to be determined as well as IRoQ.
- 032 Paul Woodward tabled a proposal for additional wording to be added to event's supplementary regulations relevant to sponsor decal requirements etc. It was decided to adopt Paul's proposed wording. Copy of which to be sent to event organisers by Paul Woodward.
