MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:

035 The minutes from the previous meeting held on 3 June 2015 were reviewed. These will be considered by QSC at the July QSC Meeting.

BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES:

036 Ref. RAP15.028 - Rally Car Registration Scheme

A further update was given on the roll out of Rally Vehicle Registration Scheme in Queensland.

037 Ref. RAP15.030 - IRoQ Preparations

Paul Woodward reported on IRoQ which included QRC 3 and 4. It was noted that a positive FIA Observer's Report had been received which placed the event equal first (with NZ) in APRC scoring to date.

- 038 Ref. RAP15.032 - Proposed Clubman and Junior Championship or Series
Jamie Lawson's paper on the proposed 2016 Clubman and Junior Championship or Series was discussed further. This will be developed in conjunction with a recent approach from a company to sponsor the QRC with a particular emphasis on junior crew development and training.
- 039 Report received that QRC at Jimna was ready to proceed and Supplementary Regulations were ready to go to CAMS for approval.

CORRESPONDENCE:

GENERAL BUSINESS:

- 040 An approach has been received from a major company in the automotive trade expressing a desire to provide financial and other support for the development of junior and lower level rally crews in Queensland. This proposal also included support for the overall QRC in 2016. Panel members were pleased to see this approach and a face to face or teleconference meeting between the Company and QRAP will be a major part of the 5 August 2015 meeting. QSC is asked to note this development.
- 041 Discussion occurred at the meeting and out of session on the date for QRC 6 (BSCC). There has been an approach that the former October date for the AORC round at Lockyer Valley be retained and used as a QORC round. Based on this and after discussion with BSCC and Panel, it has been agreed that QRC 6 will now be held on November 14 in the Blackbutt/Benarkin area. QSC is asked to ratify this late amendment to the 2015 QRC Calendar.
- 042 Discussion was held on the development of the 2016 Rally Calendar. There was acceptance that IRoQ be a single endurance round of the QRC and subset Series in 2016. Based on inputs to date, the proposed QRC Calendar for 2016 will include:
- QRC 1 – Manumbar (BSCC) in early April;
 - QRC 2 – Wowan (CQMSC) in 3rd week of May
 - QRC 3 – IRoQ (endurance) (BSCC) 17 to 19 June
 - QRC 4 – Border Ranges Rally (GCTMSC) 1st weekend of August
 - QRC 5 – Jimna (BSCC) 1st week of November.
- QSC is asked to note the above proposed 2016 Calendar and include in future calendar considerations.
