MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:

039 The minutes from the previous meeting held on 6 April 2016 were reviewed with several action items approved at QSC April meeting.

BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES:

040 Ref. RAP16.037 - Excel Rally Car Chassis Cracking
Bob McLean will advise CAMS Technical of the potential cracking issues in Hyundai Excel competition cars including possible cracking around suspension pick-up points.

041 Ref. RAP16.029 - MRF Tyres Sponsorship
Panel noted that all MRF Tyres sponsorship material will be available at the 2nd round of the MRF Tyres QRC at Wowan on May 14. These will be distributed at Documentation.

- 042 Ref. RAP16.030 - 2016 Qld Rally Handbook
Panel noted QSC approval of amendments to 2016 Qld Rally Handbook to clarify the signage requirements and provide a signage diagram for MRF sponsorship decals. Version 3 of the Handbook is now on the CAMS Qld website and has been distributed via Panel's Facebook and Website.
- 043 QRC 2 (Wowan Rally organised by CQMSC) is ready to proceed with 42 entries including novice entries. This is a very good result and shows a strong resurgence in QRC fields.
- 044 Ref. RAP16.031 - CAMS Course Checker Manual
Panel noted that the proposed regional CAMS Course Checker Manual training will now be held in the month after the Wowan Rally (14 May). The dates will be confirmed once CAMS provides updated training material.
- 045 Ref. RAP16.032 - MRF Tyres QRC Registration Form
Panel will further investigate the need for any new software to make the new QRC registration process more user friendly. No costs have been identified yet.
- 046 Ref. RAP16.035 - Qld Rally Vehicle Registration Scheme
